## Education

Over half of RYSE youth have either graduated high school or obtained a GED.



## Living Situations

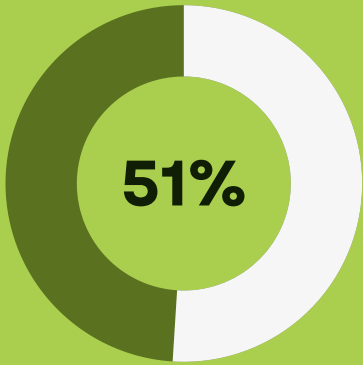
Almost 1/4 of youth were living outside before admission to RYSE

## The Cycle

38% of youth reported being homeless 4 or more times in the last 3 years

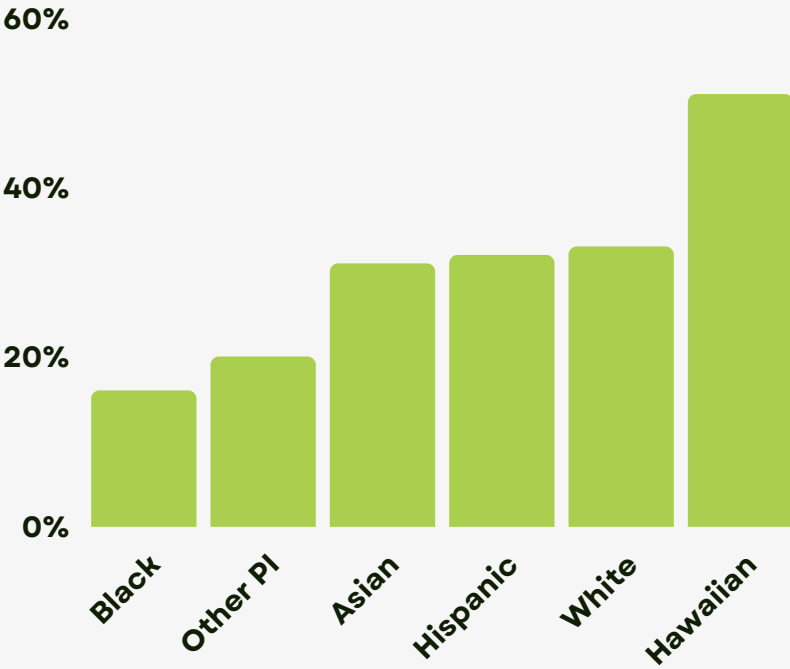
## DEMOGRAPHICS

Youth identified as Other Pacific Islander, Asian, Hispanic, White, Hawaiian, Black, Alaska Native, Samoan, Micronesian, Tongan, and Other.



### HAWAIIAN

Over half of RYSE youth identified as Native Hawaiian or Part Hawaiian.



## Causes

Youth stated the reasons for becoming houseless:

- 42% Getting kicked out
- 38% Family issues
- 38% Drinking/drug use
- 27% Employment issues



## DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

46% of youth reported experiencing domestic violence.

## Parental Support

35% of youth entering RYSE reported that they have no parental involvement.

Since 2018, RYSE has sheltered over 485 houseless youth in Hawaii
