## FUNDING & SUPPORTERS

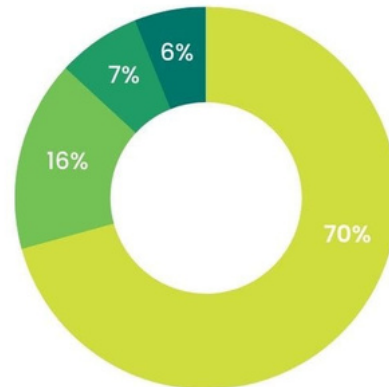
